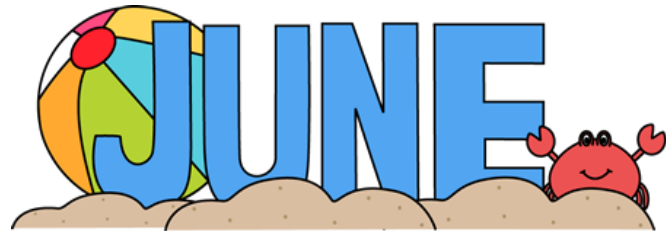

While I thank God for his love and guidance and for each one of you, I also want to thank our Sunday School teachers for helping to teach our

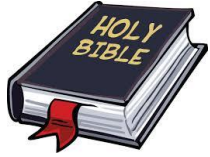
youth about our great God and our wonderful choir for enhancing our worship services with their beautiful music. Enjoy the break.

Front Porch Tales

Philip Gulley is a Quaker pastor at the Fairfield Friends Meetinghouse in Indiana, quite close to Danville, IN. He has written many books on the Quaker life, faith, spiritualism, grace, love and also works of fiction with Christian values. In this book, Gulley uses his own life experiences as a child growing up in a small town to examine how he learned his values from the people he met and the situations he got into.

'Front Porch Tales' is a well-written, easy to read book with each chapter feeling like a 'remember when we . . .' story ending with a lesson learned. I have to believe that writing this book was better than years in therapy for Pastor Gulley! By looking back at how life lessons were learned, Gulley also seems to be writing almost a thank you letter to many people that were there for him as a child. It may even make the reader think about how they learned similar values and who they have to thank! Definitely a 'feel good' read!

Tapioca Fruit Salad

From *Feed the Flock Cookbook*

- 1 large can chunk pineapple
- 1 large can mandarin oranges
- 2 boxes tapioca pudding
- 6 tablespoons pre-sweetened orange Kool-Aid
- 4 bananas sliced
- 1 jar maraschino cherries

Drain pineapple and oranges and add water to the juice to measure 3 cups liquid.
Cook tapioca in the 3 cups of liquid until thick.
Add Kool-Aid and cool for at least one hour.
Add pineapple, oranges, bananas and drained cherries and refrigerate until served.
