



Lucille's Library Corner

The Help by Kathryn Stockett

Not all the books in our library are strictly religious. The Help is a story of historical fiction set in Jackson, Mississippi in 1962 - a very segregated time and place. Kathryn Stockett weaves a very compelling story made of several different threads giving a clear, soul searching and heart-wrenching picture of the privileged whites versus the downtrodden blacks of the time. Skeeter, a white socialite, has returned from college hoping to write the next great novel. She sees her opportunity by interviewing the black maids that have been raising the white children for generations. Through Skeeter's story of what her family expects of her and the stories of the struggles of the black maids within their employment, the feelings of the era come through loud and clear. This is obviously a story of segregation but it is also a story of empathy, strength, humor and perseverance.

April Recipe

Sue Wenzelman's Orange Raisin Pecan Bread

From First Presbyterian's 2012 <u>Feed the Flock</u> <u>Cookbook</u>

½ cup orange juice

½ cup water

1 Tbs grated orange peel

1 cup sugar

2 Tbs melted butter

1 beaten egg

2 cups flour

1 tsp baking soda

1 tsp salt

1 cup golden raisins

3/4 cup chopped pecans

- Preheat oven to 350F.

Mix the wet ingredients together. Combine flour, baking soda, and salt. Add dry to wet ingredients.

Add raisins and pecans then mix well. Pour into greased loaf pan and bake 50 to 65 minutes until toothpick comes out clean.
